Returning to classes

1 We will have a separate entrance and exit system.

Everyone will wait outside until invited in (sorry no parents to come in side)

2 On entry hand sanitisers will be available.

3 There will be hand sanitisers at exit and placed around the hall

4 Classes will be restricted in number to accommodate 2 meter distancing.

5 Everyone will be asked to come ready dressed (no changing room), outdoor shoes and coats a space will be allocated to put these.

6 Toilets will be available with cleaning after each use, plenty of soap to wash hands and paper towel to dry them.

7 The doors and windows will be open to keep air flow through the hall.

8 No hugging each other I know it's been a long time that some of you haven't seen each other.

9 No singing but hopefully we can do that outside.

10 Please don't come if not feeling well or any one in your family is feeling poorly.

Cleaning

Risk Assessment

for keeping Shears Green safe after each session and at the end of day.

1 Open all windows and doors to stop air transmitted germs.

2 Clean toilets.

3 Clean all hard surfaces (floors ,work top, door handles, window shutters etc, and anything anybody has touched.)

All the cleaning will be done wearing PPE using Disinfectant (Bleach) and sanitising cleaning products (hopefully supplied by GBC)
